11.00 to 12.00	<p>EUROPEAN DEFENCE FUND – Ms. Océane Le Bot and Mr. Colin Ruel, Pôle Mer Méditerranée</p> <p>This new funding programme aims at coordinating and increasing national investment in defence research and improve interoperability between national forces.</p> <p>The fund has two stands:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Research (€90 million until the end of 2019 and €500 million per year after 2020) - Development & acquisition (€500 million in total for 2019-20 then €1 billion per year after 2020). <p>The European Commission announces that the budget for 2021-2027 will be €13 billion</p> <p>Specific attention will be paid to the 2019 topics:</p>
